



Education at school level has to be absolutely child centric. Holistic development of the pupils can be achieved by engaging and involving them through fruitful learning.












# BHASHA SANGAM

### NATURE AND BIO DIVERSITY



#### CAREER COUNSELLING SESSION BY DBEE, MOHALI





# Visit to DEO Office S.A.S Nagar




It was bane for humans,


